**Join us in Amsterdam on 17th June 2006:
Myeloma Euronet Treatment Update and International Panel Discussion
on Access to Treatment and Care for Myeloma Patients in Europe**

Myeloma Euronet, the European Network of Myeloma Patient groups, is pleased to announce its first international myeloma treatment update as well as an international panel discussion about access to treatment and care for myeloma patients in Europe. The update and panel discussion will take place on Saturday, 17 June 2006 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at rooms Prins Hendrik I + III at the NH Barbizon Palace Hotel, Prins Hendrikkade, 59-72, 1012AD Amsterdam, which is located in the city centre, in short walking distance from the Amsterdam Central Station.

From 9 a.m. to 12.30 p.m., leading myeloma experts from different countries will share information on what is new in myeloma treatment and care and will answer to questions from the audience. Starting at 2 p.m., the international panel discussion will include a presentation of recent data on multiple myeloma treatment access in Europe and provide an opportunity to discuss with a panel of European opinion leaders about what can be done to improve access to myeloma treatment and care in Europe. Presentations and discussions will be patient-friendly and easy-to-understand also for 'non-experts'; the main language will be English but we will also try to translate audience contributions in other languages.
